Providing a Framework for Effective Process Safety Management

Summary of Approach

Step 2 - Roadmap and project plan: Prioritised list of gaps that, if addressed, would deliver improvements or reduce risks with quantifiable ROI

Step 3 - Business Case Development: In-depth cost benefit analysis addressing the key areas of the roadmap to develop a robust business case

Step 4 - Executive Workshop: Delivered in partnership with Amor's process safety experts and the organisation's process safety champion, the workshop is designed to provide executives with all key information required to commence the journey to process safety maturity.

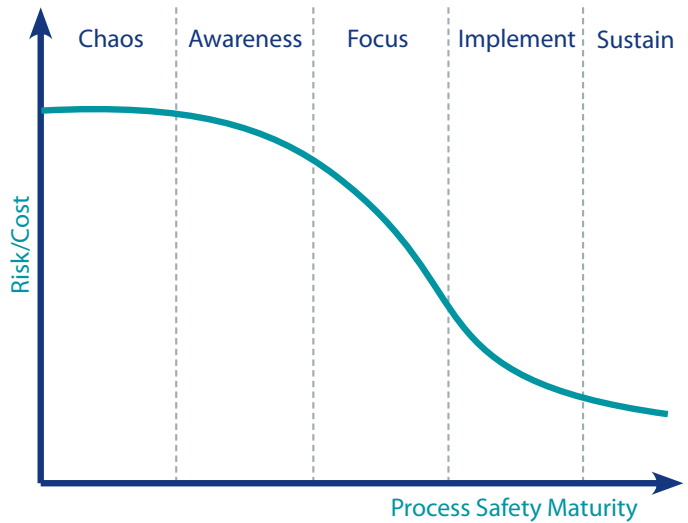




Benefits of a Mature Approach
